

Break-Down of 12 Month I-20 & DS-2019 Living Estimates for 2012-2013

▶ INTERNATIONAL STUDENT ORIENTATION FEE: \$175 (one-time fee)

▶ FOOD: \$5,400 (\$450/month or \$113/week)

▶ MISCELLANEOUS: \$2,400 (\$200/month or \$50/week)

▶ HEALTH INSURANCE (includes summer coverage)

-Student Only: \$3,070

-Student & Spouse: \$6,743

-Student, Spouse, & 1 Child: \$16,950

▶ HOUSING/RENT & UTILITIES

-Single Graduate Student: \$8,925 (Cost of furnished roommate apartment in Regent Village for 12 months (\$8800), plus \$125 for renters insurance, with all utilities included. Laundry not included.)
(Regent Village)

-Single Undergraduate Student: \$7,040 (Average cost of the 4 Commons Apts. for 12 months (\$6915), plus \$125 for renter's insurance, with all utilities & laundry included. See "Special Notes" below.)
(Regent Commons)

-Student & Spouse/Family: \$12,825 (Average cost of 3 "family" configuration Regent Village Apts. for 12 months (\$11,140), plus \$130 electricity for 12 months (\$1560), plus \$125 renter's insurance. Laundry fees are not included at the Village.)
(Regent Village)

▶ DEPENDENTS

For a Spouse: \$2,664 (\$222/month)

For Each Child: \$1,332 (\$111/month per child)

TOTAL 12 Month Living Estimates for 2012-2013

▶ SINGLE GRADUATE STUDENT:

\$175 + \$5,400 + \$2,400 + \$3,070 + \$8,925 = \$19,970 (+\$1500 Books) = \$21,470 Total (\$1789/month)

▶ SINGLE UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT:

\$175 + \$5,400 + \$2,400 + \$3,070 + \$7,040 = \$18,805 (+\$1500 Books) = \$19,585 Total (\$1632/month)

▶ STUDENT & SPOUSE:

\$175 + \$5,400 + \$2,400 + \$6,743 + \$12,825 + \$2,664 = \$30,207 (+\$1500 Books) = \$31,707 Total (\$2642/month)

▶ FAMILY (STUDENT, SPOUSE, & 1 CHILD):

\$175 + \$5,400 + \$2,400 + \$16,950 + \$12,825 + \$2,664 + \$1,332 = \$41,746 (+\$1500 Books) = \$43,246 (\$3604/month)

*Plus \$1,000 for each additional child.

Special Notes:

--Tuition costs & fees are not included in the living estimates & can be found here: <http://www.regent.edu/admin/busoff/student.cfm>

--Those who might purchase a car/vehicle will need an additional \$4,000-5,000 for a used vehicle, plus \$1,500/year for taxes, gasoline & maintenance.

--Regent Commons undergraduate housing assignments have, on average, a lower cost as these housing assignments are "double or triple occupancy" (2 or 3 roommates sharing an assignment) rather than the "single occupancy" housing assignments for graduate students (which is 1 resident with an entire apartment to him/herself).
