***The I-20/DS-2019 Issuance Deadline:** If the I-20/DS-2019 is not issued by this date, the student's admission will be deferred for the following Fall term. By this deadline all admissions documents must be received; an acceptance must be made on the application; all financial documents must be submitted with all requirements; and the international enrollment deposit (\$5,500) must be paid.
